SEESAW EXPECTATIONS - SCHOOL

RATIONALE:

At Watervale Primary School, we are dedicated to transforming teaching and learning through the use of technology. We value curiosity and creativity to develop critical and collaborative thinkers. We are committed to preparing our students to be innovative and responsible members of a global community.

AIM:

To engage families in their child's learning through the Seesaw platform therefore, creating dialogue within the child's home environment about learning tasks, group activities and community initiatives. To create a triangle of communication between parents, teacher and students. To engage our students in the respectful, safe and creative use of digital devices.

EXPECTATIONS:

- All class teachers are expected to post a minimum of weekly with an overview of learning that has occurred.
- Specialist teachers are expected to post a minimum of once per term for each class with an overview of the learning that has occurred.
- Students in years 3-7 are expected to post once per week on their learning, a photo/video of something they are proud of or demonstrate their learning through a drawing/voice over.
- Students in years R-2 are expected to post a minimum of once a fortnight with support from their buddies, class teacher or student support officer.
- Parents can contact teachers via SeeSaw messages or via email. Teachers will respond at earliest convenience. For urgent messages please contact the school office.
- Teachers will refrain from answering after hour messages from parents/caregivers.
